- All candidates eligible for JAE may also download a copy of Form A from the JAE-Internet System (JAE-IS) using Singpass during the application period.

Before accessing JAE website at (www.moe.gov.sg/jae), you are encouraged to complete the JAE worksheet (www.moe.gov.sg/jaeworksheet)

- Make full use of the <u>12 choices</u> (listed in order of preference)
- Will require NRIC or FIN, Singpass
- Takes approximately 15 minutes



Posting Results via SMS

- Upon successful submission, the verification slip will be sent to the email address you provided
- Print Verification Slip and retain a copy of it as proof of course application

Posting Results

- Scheduled for release on Tuesday 4 February 2025 through
 - JAE-IS (accessible through JAE website)
 - SMS to Singapore mobile phone number provided by applicant during registration

JAE Posting

- Do consider your course choices wisely. Posting is based on merit according to your net aggregate scores (taking into account the various bonus points eligible).
- Make use of all your **12 choices**. Advisable to indicate at least 2-3 courses where your aggregate scores are much better then the previous year's course cut-off points (COP).
- Appeals for transfer to another JC are not likely to be successful unless you meet the COP of the JC course for that year's JAE.

JAE / JIE for O Level Students

- If you did not receive a JAE posting, ITE might offer you a
 place in a Nitec course soon after the release of the JAE
 posting results.
- If you hear from ITE, do consider the offer carefully, as it will give you a chance to continue your studies.
- If you have accepted ITE's offer, you still have the option of appealing for a Higher Nitec course during JAE appeals.

JAE Appeals

- Which courses should I appeal for?
 - You can only appeal for courses where you meet the current year's cut-off point, as well as the Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs)
 - Refer to the JAE appeals website for information on the net aggregate range for specific courses for the current year
 - Refer to the JAE booklet for information on the subject-specific MERs on courses that you are interested to appeal
 - Apply for a range of courses offered by ITE as appeal postings are subject to available vacancies



JAE Appeals

- How do I appeal for a course?
 - Submit your appeal through the JAE appeals website: https://jaeappeal.edu.sg
 - Use all your 6 JAE appeals choices carefully
 - For additional advice, you can approach your school teachers, ECG counsellor and parents, or visit the ECG centre at MOE Grange Road

After JAE Appeals

How do I check for my JAE appeals outcome?

- You will be informed of your appeal outcome through the online appeals portal, as well as through SMS notifications
- Look out for your appeal outcome, and consider the course you were posted to carefully

After JAE Appeals

Can I still appeal after the end of JAE appeals?

- Yes, you can still appeal directly to ITE for courses that you are interested in
- You can do this even if you have accepted the posting offered through JAE appeals

 - Released on Wednesday 22 Jan 2025 at 1.30pm through PFP website
- Acceptance Period
 - To indicate whether you wish to accept, reject or appeal for change of course by 4.00pm Monday 26 Jan 2025



Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- Secondary 4 N(A) students who are newly eligible after taking into account their O-Level examination results should submit their DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses
- Application Period
 - Start date: Friday 10 Jan 2025 at 12.00am
 - End date: Tuesday 14 Jan 2025 at 11.59pm



Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- Posting Results
 - Released on Wednesday 17 Jan 2025 at 9.00am through DPP application portal
- Acceptance Period
 - To indicate whether you wish to accept, reject or appeal for change of course by 11.59pm on Tuesday 21 Jan 2025

For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have been offered a place in the **DPP** under the final application phase should report to ITE on **Wednesday, 22 January 2025** upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.
- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a
 place in the PFP will be on Friday, 31 January 2025. Students will be
 informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the
 PFP.
- Students who accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but have now decided to take up a PFP offer will need to apply to ITE to withdraw from the DPP first, before they are able to take up the PFP offer.
